To be eligible for assistance, clients must be residents of Madison County, NC. For Heating Assistance, the Neighbors in Need program begins on the first Tuesday in December. The one-time heating assistance payment per household is for a 12-month period. There is assistance for electric heat, heating oil, propane, kerosene, and firewood. Clients can sign up for assistance in advance if they believe they will need help in the coming winter. After the client's eligibility is determined, they will receive a postcard in the mail with the amount of assistance for which they are eligible. Clients can apply in person at AB Tech Madison Campus. If a client urgently needs assistance, they can bring their heating bill statement to Neighbors in Need at the above address to apply. Clients 60 years of age or older must first apply to DSS for assistance. If they still need heating assistance after applying to DSS, they can then apply to Neighbors in Need. Assistance for non-heating electric bills is available year-round. For non-heating electrical bills, the stipend is \$100.00 for an individual and \$200.00 for a household.
